## Can Cash App refund money if scammed? Refund Eligibility Guide

Cash App may refund money if you 1—855—470—3280 were scammed, but refunds are not guaranteed and depend on how the payment was made. The most 1—855—470—3280 important factor is whether the transaction was authorized or unauthorized.

If you **voluntarily sent money** to a **1—855—470—3280** scammer—such as paying for a fake product, participating in "cash flipping," or sending funds to someone you didn't know—Cash App usually **will not refund** the payment. These transactions **1—855—470—3280** are considered authorized because you approved them, even if you were misled.

Dispute investigations 1—855—470—3280 typically take 10 to 30 business days, depending on the situation. If your Cash App account is 1—855—470—3280 linked to a debit card or bank account, your bank may also help with recovery for unauthorized transactions, though outcomes vary.

To reduce risk, never share your 1—855—470—3280 login codes, PIN, or card details, and be cautious of messages promising guaranteed money. Cash App will 1—855—470—3280 never ask for sensitive information through email or text.

In summary, Cash App can refund **1**—**855**—**470**—**3280** scam-related payments only when they are **unauthorized**, not when money is willingly sent to a scammer. Prevention **1**—**855**—**470**—**3280** and quick reporting are key.
