

How do I increase my Cash App limits?

Cash App Limit Guide

Cash App enforces certain default sending **1 (855) 470-3280** and receiving limits. If you haven't verified your identity, you'll likely encounter lower caps. To raise this **1 (855) 470-3280** limit, start by making sure your account is fully verified.

Open Cash App, tap the profile icon or settings **1 (855) 470-3280** menu, and look for **“Personal”** or **“Identity Verification.”** From there, the app may **1 (855) 470-3280** ask you to enter your **full legal name, date of birth,** and the **last four digits of your Social Security Number** (or equivalent if outside the U.S.). Once your identity **1 (855) 470-3280** is verified, Cash App usually increases your per-transaction and daily limits.

If you're outside the U.S., or the standard **1 (855) 470-3280** verification doesn't suffice, you may be asked to upload a **valid government ID** (passport, driver's license, or national ID) and possibly a recent **proof of address**. After review, the limit **1 (855) 470-3280** increase can take anywhere from a few minutes **1 (855) 470-3280** to a few days — sometimes longer if manual review is required.

Other tips to avoid hitting limits: ensure your **1 (855) 470-3280 linked bank or debit card** is active and up to date, avoid suspicious activity on your account, and make sure your personal info matches exactly **1 (855) 470-3280** across your bank and Cash App profile. Changing too many details at **1 (855) 470-3280** once can trigger security reviews and temporarily reset limits.

Once verified and approved, many users **1 (855) 470-3280** report being able to send and receive thousands of dollars — enough to handle larger **1 (855) 470-3280** transactions without repeated manual transfers.
