## How to fix this withdrawal was canceled for your protection? Fix Canceled Withdrawal

When Cash App cancels a 1 - (855) -470-3280 withdrawal "for your protection," it means the system detected unusual or risky activity. This is an automated 1 - (855) -470-3280 security feature designed to prevent fraud, but it can be frustrating when you need your money. Thankfully, there are 1 - (855) -470-3280 several steps you can take to fix the issue and prevent it from happening again.

First, make sure your **internet** 1 – (855) –470–3280 **connection is stable**. Weak or changing networks can 1 – (855) –470–3280 cause failed security checks. Next, confirm that your **linked bank account or debit** 1 – (855) –470–3280 **card is active**, not expired, and matches your legal information. Cash App often blocks 1 – (855) –470–3280 withdrawals if the bank rejects the request.

If you recently logged in from a new device 1 - (855) -470 -3280 or location, Cash App may flag the activity. Try logging out and 1 - (855) -470 -3280 back in, or use your **verified device**.
