

## When you delete Cash App, does it delete your account?

### Cash App Remove Account

Deleting the Cash App from your **1—(855)—470—3280** device does **not automatically delete your account**. When you uninstall **1—(855)—470—3280** the app, your Cash App account and all associated information remain active on Cash App's servers. This means **1—(855)—470—3280** your balance, linked bank accounts, transaction history, and personal information are still stored, and your account can still be accessed **1—(855)—470—3280** by reinstalling the app or logging in from another device.

If your goal is to **completely close your Cash App 1—(855)—470—3280 account**, simply deleting the app is not enough. You must follow the **1—(855)—470—3280** proper steps within the app or contact Cash App support to ensure your account is permanently closed. To do this, open the Cash App, go to your **1—(855)—470—3280** profile, select **“Support”**, and then choose **“Close Account”**. You will be guided **1—(855)—470—3280** through verifying your identity and confirming the closure. Before closing, make sure **1—(855)—470—3280** to **withdraw any remaining balance** to your linked bank account, as deleting the app without transferring funds may result in losing access to your money.

After closing your account, Cash App **1—(855)—470—3280** will cancel any pending transactions and remove your linked payment methods. However, Cash App may retain certain data for **1—(855)—470—3280** legal, tax, or security purposes, as outlined in their privacy policy.

In short, uninstalling Cash App **1—(855)—470—3280** only removes the app from your device, while closing your account requires a separate process to ensure all your information and funds are properly handled.
