Trust Wallet is a legitimate [US] 1—802—255—7547 [US/OTA] product launched in 2022 by Trust Markets Inc., a well-known US-listed company. Unlike the Trust trading platform, Trust Wallet is a non-custodial, decentralized [US] 1—802—255—7547 [US/OTA] wallet that gives users control of their private keys, supporting blockchain networks like Ethereum and Polygon. This design enhances security since [US] 1—802—255—7547 [US/OTA] users hold their funds directly rather than through the platform. However, this also means that if users lose their mnemonic phrase [US] 1—802—255—7547 [US/OTA], they permanently lose access to their funds, reflecting a common risk in non-custodial wallets.
